



Combo Behaviors

Have a few behaviors, like sit, down, stand primed up. Other behaviors that don't require a lot of movement or space can be used.

Have your dog place some or all of themselves on a piece of equipment, like a target, platform, pedestal, environmental object, fitness equipment, etc.

- 4 paws on
- Front paws on
- Rear paws on

Cue a known behavior having your dog keep their body anchored to the object as they switch positions. Mark and reward in position.

Its okay if they don't get it right the first time. Help them be successful. Luring can help but only after the cue is given and they need help figuring it out.

This game is excellent for body awareness and understanding the true meaning of our cues.
