INSTRUCTIONS

This exercise is an occasion to demonstrate your ability to explain and communicate content to a high school student. Using a segment of text (humanities), a topic presentation (math, sciences), or an artifact (fine arts) from the text selections on page 2 or any of the topics covered in our Curriculum Overview on page 3, record a 5 - 8 minute video demonstration including the following:

- 1. Introduce yourself with your first and last name and the discipline(s) you are interested in teaching
- 2. Provide brief overview of text / piece
- 3. Read selection and provide exposition
- 4. Explain relevance of ideas and arguments to subject/discipline
- 5. Conclude with a memorable summary of the ideas

The following pages will provide a list of title selections and topics that come from our Chesterton Schools Network curriculum which you may select from to complete this demonstration. We prefer you to choose a piece from this list of titles or topics, however you may select a comparable piece to use for your demonstration video.
