Tell us one of your favorite memories from your time at GLA.

I love Lit Pit every Friday! It reminds me of being in school myself, and the Culture Team bring such a great community-oriented energy every time.

Tell us one of your proudest teacher moments.

One of my proudest moments for sure has been being able to encourage my students and speak life into them whenever they feel that the ELA/Reading/Writing is daunting. Having been a young student of color, I understand how important it is to feel that your teacher genuinely believes in you for every aspect of who you are.

What made you want to become a teacher (or what made you want to work in a school)? Coming from a family of educators (classroom teachers, learning behavior specialists, principals, and professors), I grew up with a real value for education and for teaching as a profession. When I was little, I used to model lessons for my little cousins because we always had flex charts laying around in the house! But for a while, I felt I wanted to do something different than everyone else in my family. After graduating college with degrees in English, History, and African and African Diaspora (Black) Studies, I realized that teaching is a career that I make my own and where I can focus many of the interests I care about and the ones I studied in college.

What keeps you coming back to GLA every day?

I grew up on the South Side of Chicago and my mom, grandparents, and little sister live 5 minutes from here, so I feel a real connection to the cause of pouring back into the community that poured so much into me. And I love our GLA community here! Every single day, I feel welcomed.

Where are you originally from? (If Chicago, tell us what neighborhood!) What do you love about that place?

I am a fifth generation Chicagoan! My family migrated from Biloxi, Mississippi during the Great Migration and I take a lot of pride in our history. I was raised in the South Side of Chicago (mainly Hyde Park and South Shore). My parents actually met at Whitney Young.

What's your favorite thing to do in Chicago?

I love to swim in the lake (it's cold I know). I also love restaurants and am always trying to

find the next best one.

What are your hidden or surprising talents? I can juggle!

PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

As we begin Quarter 2, I would like to share a few reminders to help students continue developing strong homework routines and academic success. Parents, please encourage your scholar to follow a consistent nightly routine. Structure helps students stay organized, focused, and engaged in learning.

Homework reinforces classroom learning, strengthens the home–school connection, and helps students build good study habits. It should mostly be independent practice, with parents providing support only when needed. To help students focus, ensure homework is completed in a quiet, distraction-free space without TVs or other screens, unless required for an assignment.

K-2 Families:

Paloma Parent Tutoring is a text-based app that gives parents simple, personalized math and reading lessons based on school assessments. Each 15-minute activity includes guided and independent practice. We encourage families to complete these lessons at least three times per week.

GLA will offer after-school enrichment programming that is instructor led by teachers, staff, and community partners. If you are interested in enrolling your scholar, click here! Programs meet twice weekly on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday only. If you want your scholar enrolled Monday-Thursday, you will have to sign them up for two programs on the respective days. If you want two days, you will need to sign them up for only one.

Programs will only run in one wave, unless renewed and new programs will be offered each wave where you will have to re-sign up. The waves are as follows:

- Wave One: Monday, August 25th Thursday, November 13th
- Wave Two: Monday, November 17th Thursday, February 26th
- Wave Three: Monday, March 2nd Thursday, May 28th

Sign ups will close on Tuesday, November 11th for Wave Two. You will be notified if you get into the program by Wednesday, November 12th via letter and email.


All programs will run 3:15-5:00 pm. Cost: *\$175/each program/per wave.

New Payment Option Now Available

We are excited to announce that our school now offers a new, convenient way to pay student fees online through **RevTrak**, available directly in the **PowerSchool Parent Portal**.

With RevTrak, you can securely pay for fees such as enrichment, technology, and other school-related costs using a credit or debit card—all from your existing PowerSchool account.

How to Access RevTrak:

- Log in to your PowerSchool Parent Portal.
- Click on the Balance tab.
- Select the applicable fee(s) and complete your payment.

To make payments more convenient, PayPal will no longer be available for online transactions. All balances and payments will now be accessible in one place through the PowerSchool Parent Portal. In addition, in-person payments will continue to be accepted at the Front Office.

Please note: Outstanding balances not secured by a payment plan will result in ineligibility to enroll in future programs.




