Academic Intervention

Beacon Boost is a critical component of our Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) framework, designed to provide intensive, individualized instruction for students who need additional support in English Language Arts (ELA) and Math. MTSS uses three tiers of support to help every student succeed:

- Tier 1: Core Instruction
 - What: High-quality classroom teaching for all students
 - Who: Everyone receives this support
- Tier 2: Targeted Support
 - What: Extra help for students who need a boost
 - Who: Small groups of students who need more practice.
 - When: This takes place during math block 2, Intervention block and wide read.
 - All students have received a parent letter for IRLA level and/or iready.
- Tier 3: Intensive Support (Beacon Boost)
 - What: One-on-one or very small group help
 - Who: Students who need the most support
 - When: During the day and after school
 - Students identified as Tier 3 have received a letter or will receive one today.
