If your child is found to be responsible for creating or contributing to these pages, we will follow up with appropriate consequences as outlined in our student code of conduct.

If you did not receive the handout and/or email notification, or if you have any questions, please contact the front office at 773-530-3040.

#### Powerschool

- Used for: Current student grades and attendance
- To Access Your Student's Data: Your student brought home a handout last week.
- Parent/Guardian Action Steps:
  1. Ask your student for the handout.
  2. Follow the instructions on the handout to create an account and link the account to each student you have enrolled at GLA.

#### Unified Classroom Behavior Supports

- Used for: Student behavior and weekly paycheck report
- To Access Your Student's Data: You should have received an email from Unified Classroom Behavior Support.
- Parent/Guardian Action Steps:
  1. Check your email later today for an email from Unified Classroom Behavior Supports
  2. Follow the instructions in the email to set up your account.

*Please Note: Accessing your student's grades and behavior data requires setting up the two separate accounts detailed above. Both accounts should be set up for parent/guardian use only (do not share access information) as student personally identifiable information will be shared.*

We are asking parents to spend 15 minutes each night “tutoring” their child through Paloma. This type of focused, high dosage tutoring has been shown to have a positive impact on student academic development.
