PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

Next week is an extra important week for our students and our school. All 3rd-8th graders will be taking the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR). This is a required state assessment of grade level standards in English Language Arts and Math. There will be testing <u>each morning</u> from Monday, April 7th to Thursday, April 10th. It is extremely important for all students to be in attendance for this test each day. Please ensure your student is on time to school each day (no later than 8:00) and gets a good night's sleep each night so they can be their best!

For students, this state assessment is important because it tells us how students are progressing academically on state standards for their grade level. For GLA, the assessment is important because it is a major measure on GLA's Illinois Report Card. Our students' performance last year helped improve our overall index score on the Illinois Report Card where we earned another "Commendable" rating (and just missed an "Exemplary" rating). Once again, Great Lakes Academy had the highest student proficiency rates in ELA and Math of all schools in South Chicago, South Shore, Woodlawn, and Hyde Park. GLA was also in the 79th and 94th percentile of schools for ELA and Math growth, respectively, and ranked as the 4th best elementary charter school in Illinois according to US News & World Report.

GLA's accomplishments are impossible without the help of you, our parents. Be sure to send your students well wishes and encouragement for testing!
