Upcoming Test Dates

- IRLA: May 19 June 3 (Grades K-4)
- ANET: May 21-22, with make-ups on May 23 (Grades 2-8)
- iReady: May 19-20, with make-ups on May 23 (All grades)
- Math Interim Assessment 4:
 - K-1st: May 28
 - 2nd-4th Grade: May 20
 - 5th, 7th, 8th Grades: May 22
 - 6th Grade: May 28

Summer EBT Program



If you have school-aged kids, you may be able to get help buying groceries this summer.

Summer EBT can give breathing room in your family's budget so you can provide your kids the nutrition they love.

• Families will receive **\$120 for each eligible child to purchase groceries** when school is out this summer.

• You can get Summer EBT even if your child gets free meals at school, camp, or other places this summer.
