

Please note that only students with completed consent forms will be eligible to be seen.


If you have not yet signed up your scholar and would like them to participate, you may visit the GLA front office to complete a consent form.

OpenSeat- Middle School

This year, our school is once again partnering with OpenSeat to increase access to mental health and well-being support for our students. OpenSeat offers students one-on-one, short-term virtual wellness coaching to address a range of issues they may struggle with, including anxiety, academic stress, motivation, sadness, or loss.

Through OpenSeat, your student will have access to:

- secure, virtual, and 1:1 access to OpenSeat's trained and supervised coaches via video or chat
- diverse wellness professionals with years of professional experience supporting students
- Short-term, flexible coaching is available during the school day. (never during core classes)

All middle school families will receive an email this week explaining more about OpenSeat. In the email, there will be an Opt-Out Form for guardians who do not want their student to access OpenSeat virtual wellness coaching. 2025-26 5th - 8th Grade Parents
