First, a huge congratulations to our staff, teachers, and students on improving GLA's State Report Card score and earning another Commendable rating. We are continuing to stay focused on delivering quality instruction so students can grow and achieve academically. In a strategic effort to serve our students even better, we made significant increases to our academic intervention capacity by launching our afterschool Beacon Boost Program. This program consists of K-3 On Your Mark

(OYM) virtual tutoring, Paloma Parent Tutoring, and ELA and Math Intervention by two interventionists on staff. We are working diligently with students to help them meet their academic goals.

Alongside our academic achievements, we have added programming to increase community amongst our students, staff, and our parent body.
