
Fall Fest Spirit Week (10/14-10/17)

Government ID Needed to Enter Building - Visitor ID Scanning Begins October 6 Starting Monday, October 6, all visitors - including parents and guardians - will be required to scan a government-issued ID to enter the school building. The scan conducts background checks against Sex Offender Registries, Criminal Databases, and Government Watch Lists. Once your ID has been scanned, you will not need to do so again for future visits.

These measures are in place to help keep our students, staff, and community safe. Please note that individuals who do not pass the screening may be denied entry.

CPS Family Income Information Form

We are strongly encouraging all families to complete the CPS Family Income Information Form for the 2025–2026 school year. This form is required annually and helps determine school funding, which supports important programs at GLA, including our free lunch program.

- ✓ Only one form per household is needed
- ✓ Takes just 2–3 minutes to complete
