PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

Parents, over the last couple years we heard requests for more student academic intervention programs in our afterschool enrichment programs. We heard your voice and made changes to provide more of that programming. This week I wanted to inform you of the several academic intervention programs we are offering this year at GLA through our "Beacon Boost" program.

Paloma Parent Tutoring is a text based app that provides K-2 parents with the tools to help their scholar with math and reading at home. Each day, participating parents will be sent individualized reading or math lessons based on skill areas of need from school assessments. The 15 minute daily lesson encourages parents to familiarize themselves with the content, practice with their child, then allow the student to do independent practice with guidance. Please see more information about Paloma in the announcements below.

K-3 On Your Mark (OYM) tutoring is a free program offering select K-3 students. It offers tailored 2:1 virtual literacy tutoring to support growth in specific literacy skills identified through assessment. Students participating in OYM tutoring receive it 4x per week, The program runs from October 14th through December 12th this semester, and there will be another session in the second semester.

Beacon Boost ELA and Math Intervention is being provided to targeted groups of students afterschool 2x per week by 4 GLA instructors. Instruction is targeted to address skill gaps identified through our schoolwide iReady assessment.

Each of these programs we are offering are free. We are hoping that this additional academic support will help students grow faster and flourish academically.

Powerschool

- Used for: Current student grades and attendance
- To Access Your Student's Data: Your student brought home a handout last week.
- Parent/Guardian Action Steps:
- 1. Ask your student for the handout.
- 2. Follow the instructions on the handout to create an account and link the account to each student you have enrolled at GLA.

Unified Classroom Behavior Supports

- Used for: Student behavior and weekly paycheck report
- To Access Your Student's Data: You should have received an email from Unified Classroom Behavior Support.
- Parent/Guardian Action Steps:
- Check your email later today for an email from Unified Classroom Behavior Supports
- 2. Follow the instructions in the email to set up your account.

Please Note: Accessing your student's grades and behavior data requires setting up the two separate accounts detailed above. Both accounts should be set up for parent/guardian use only (do not share access information) as student personally identifiable information will be shared.

Paloma - K-2 Family Tutoring

On Monday, September 30th, we launched Paloma to our K-2 families. Paloma is a technology platform that provides daily reading or math skill activities that families can practice with their child at home. Each day, Paloma sends a text from the number



57536 with a link to a lesson. By clicking the link, the parent will be directed to watch a very brief video on a skill that is individualized for their child. Then, the parent practices the skill with their student. Please see more info about <u>Paloma here.</u>

We are asking parents to spend 15 minutes each night "tutoring" their child through Paloma. This type of focused, high dosage tutoring has been shown to have a positive impact on student academic development.


