## PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

Parents, this week I wanted to resend a message that was in a Weekly Wave from last September. Though we have made substantial progress with school culture and physical incidents over the past three years, we still have room for improvement. Last year, we went to great lengths messaging to students and families how our entire community can be a safer community for students. We need parents to align with us supporting these messages. Here is the message:

Across the country, schools have reported increased challenges with student behavior, bullying, and aggression since returning to full in-person learning three years ago. Despite schools' best efforts, some students have struggled with the transition back into school more than others. We have seen similar trends at GLA.

Overall, incidents of physical and verbal aggression have continued to decrease this year. However, we all want a school environment where these incidents <u>never</u> <u>happen</u> so that students always feel physically and emotionally safe. As educators, we have noticed trends that lead to escalating situations:

- Students touching other students in playful but unwanted ways (e.g. grabbing, hitting, pushing, pulling, kicking, etc.);
- Students gossiping or saying mean things about other students;
- Students having a disagreement or conflict with another student that leads to using physical aggression when confrontation occurs;

Each of these issues can be minimized by teaching students the appropriate ways to respond. At GLA, we constantly message to students the following:

- We keep our hands and feet to ourselves.
- We say kind things to our peers.
- When we have a disagreement or conflict with a peer, we tell a staff member to help us resolve it.

We need the support of our entire parent body to reinforce these messages. It will make an even healthier school culture for our student body, and help them continue their growth toward having healthy relationships as teenagers and adults.
