

Title IX Training

On January 24, 2013, Gov. Pat Quinn signed a new law, Erin's Law, into effect for all Illinois schools. Erin's Law requires schools to provide age-appropriate sexual abuse prevention education for all students, Pre-K - 12, on an annual basis. In accordance with state and federal law, all students in Pre-K through 12th grade will receive age-appropriate training from the District. The Office of Student Protections and Title IX has collaborated across several departments to create developmentally appropriate sessions that help students identify abuse and empower them to report any wrongdoing. The sessions have been broken down by grade and are approximately 30-45 minutes each. The training will take place on Wednesday, November 19th, 2025.

This is an important learning opportunity for students. However, a parent or guardian may opt their child out of the training if they do not wish for them to participate. Thanks for Giving




