OpenSeat (Middle School Students)

We are going into our third year with OpenSeat. OpenSeat provides 1:1 and small group short-term virtual wellness coaching to students to address a host of issues we know students may struggle with, such as anxiety, academic stress, motivation, sadness, or loss.

Through OpenSeat, your student will have access to:

- secure, virtual, 1:1 and small group access to OpenSeat's trained and supervised coaches via video or chat
- diverse wellness professionals with years of professional experience supporting students
- Short-term, flexible coaching available during the school day.

After-School Enrichment Programming

GLA will offer after-school enrichment programming that is instructor led by teachers, staff, and community partners. If you are interested in enrolling your scholar, <u>click here!</u>

Programs meet twice weekly on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday only. If you want your scholar enrolled Monday-Thursday, you will have to sign them up for two programs on the respective days. If you want two days, you will need to sign them up for only one.

Programs will only run in one wave, unless renewed and new programs will be offered each wave where you will have to re-sign up. The waves are as follows:

- Wave One: Monday, August 26th Thursday, November 14th
- Wave Two: Monday, November 18th Thursday, February 27th
- Wave Three: Monday, March 3rd Thursday, May 29th

Sign ups will close on Tuesday, August 20th for Wave One. You will be notified if you get into the program by Wednesday, August 21st via letter and email.

All programs will run 3:15-5:00 pm. Cost: *\$175/each program/per wave.

Programs hired externally and that will be coming into GLA (i.e.; SkyArt, PTDYA, etc.), will be marked accordingly* with a different price on the sign up form.

NEW! Great Lakes Academy After-Care Services

In response to parent feedback, we are eager to announce the implementation of an after-care service at Great Lakes Academy for the 2024-25 school year! After-care is a supervision space for scholars to receive supper and complete homework in a safe environment until dismissal. This service is only available to enrolled GLA scholars.

Please note: The after-care service is separate from the enrichment programming.

The after-care service will operate on attendance days only from August 19th - June 6th, the final day of the 2024-25 school year. However, the first and final weeks of school are drop-in days and rates only.

Beginning on August 26th, families will have the option to pay a daily drop-in rate

(which must be notified the day prior to dismissal and paid with cash or credit card), a bi-weekly rate, a semester rate, or a full-year rate. All payments must be made in full prior to the first day of enrollment.

2024-25 School Calendar

We are sharing our 2024-25 academic calendar. There are a couple of important items to note:

- 1. The first day of school for our K-1st students will be on Friday, August 16th. The first day of school for our 2nd-8th grade students will be Monday, August 19th. This is a different start date than CPS district schools.
- 2. Our last day of school will be June 6th, a week earlier than CPS district schools.
- 3. We are pushing back our school start time to 8:00 am this school year. Doors will still open for breakfast beginning at 7:00 am just like last year. Dismissal times will be 3:20 pm on Monday-Thursday and 1:50 pm on Friday.
- 4. **NEW** We have added "Wellness Days" to our calendar that are non-holidays where school will not be in session (March 17th, April 18th, and May 1st and 2nd).
- 5. NEW GLA will resume in-person report card pick up this school year on November 1st and March 14th. Times will be communicated at a later date along with sign up information.
