PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

At the end of October, I shared exciting news about the academic growth and achievement of our scholars last school year that made us the top school in our area and one of the top 20% of schools in the state of Illinois. Though we were encouraged by the data, our staff began this school year charged to build on our momentum academically because there was more work to do—many of our students were not meeting state proficiency goals and many of those students were still far behind.

During the school year, we administer assessments tied to grade level standards to determine how students are progressing academically. These assessments also help us figure out how we are doing as a school compared to previous school years.

Most of our mid-year interim assessment data is in and the results are telling us that our students are still growing (and growing faster than they were last year!). Proficiency scores have increased schoolwide as well. Compared to last year, our data shows:

- ELA proficiency rates are 7% higher!
- Math proficiency rates are 9% higher!

As we begin 2024, our staff will continue to push scholars to the academic excellence that we know they are all capable of achieving. We need your continued support at home. Please make sure scholars are practicing at home, whether that is by completing practice lessons on iReady or reading books sent home in their blue literacy bags (lower school grades).


Uniform Reminder

Leader in Me Corner

Habit 5: Seek first to understand, then to be understood

- 1. I listen to others without interrupting.
- 2. I listen to other people's ideas and feelings.
- 3. I look other people in the eye when listening and talking.
- 4. I try to see things from other people's viewpoint.

We all see the world differently. The problem is we think we see things the same way others do. Communication is essential to understanding because no two people see, think, or experience the world the same way. Therefore, there is a great need, especially in families, to seek first to understand and talk second to understand one another's point of view.

Reflective Listening. "Listen First, Talk Second."

When speaking, the listener can use reflective listening to let the speaker know they are listening to what is being said.

Some simple examples of reflective listening:

Speaker: "I love you.

Listener: "You seem to feel love about me."

Speaker: "I don't want to talk about it. It seems like the only thing we do around here is argue."

Listener: "You seem to feel ______about _____."

The expectation is all students are here in school on time. As the weather gets colder we have noticed the number of tardies increase. Remember, GLA opens up at 7:00 a.m. You can drop your child off starting at 7:00 for free. They will get breakfast and be supervised by GLA staff.

- Showing up on time to school every day can help students develop the habit of being punctual, illustrate to them your commitment to their learning and friendships, and help reduce classroom interruptions and distractions for all students.
- Missing just 15 minutes of school twice a week equates to 3 missed school days per year!
- Kindergarten through 4th graders must be in the building by 7:55 am, and 5th-8th graders must be in the classroom at 7:55 am to avoid being tardy.

In February, we will be hosting another **Career Day** here at **GLA**!




We are looking to get a headstart on sign-ups to make the event bigger than last year and to give our scholars a great experience again!
