Tell us one of your favorite memories from your time at GLA.

They ran to say hi, seeing the students excited to not only see me but to be back in school warms my heart and reassures me that I'm in the right place ♥

Tell us one of your proudest teacher moments.

One of my proudest teacher moments was during my first year of teaching. My students had a presentation about their family, before I could even ask who wanted to present first, my quietest student raised his hand and volunteered to go first. As a teacher I felt extremely

On Monday, GLA kicked off Hispanic Heritage Month. From September 15th through October 15th, GLA will learn and celebrate the rich culture of Hispanics and their continuous contributions to our society. This year's theme is Collective Heritage: Honoring the Past, Inspiring the Future. We are observing this month as a community celebrating the triumphs and influence of Hispanic heritage.

South Chicago, the neighborhood in which GLA is located, has had a vibrant Latino community for over a century. In the early 1900's, people of Mexican descent began moving to the area to work in the South Works steel foundry owned by the U.S. Steel Corporation. Over the next couple of decades, the Mexican-American community grew and developed deep social bonds in the area. Their influence in South Chicago was strong and remains strong today. In fact, the very building that houses our gym, cafeteria, and kitchen was not long ago a Catholic church that was home to mostly Mexican-American parishioners, including parents and grandparents of some of our GLA scholars!

We have curated events and special programs to help students observe this important month. In the classrooms, students will be participating in lessons that highlight and commemorate Hispanic culture. GLA will host its first Annual Hispanic Heritage Assembly at the end of the month. This event will feature a variety of performances and presentations that celebrate the historical roots of the Hispanic community and honor their culture.

GLA families are invited to participate in the event from 3:30-4:30 in the gym.






