PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

Chicago winter weather is here already. We are hearing this winter will be colder and snowier than the last couple of winters. I wanted to provide a couple of weather-related reminders as we navigate the rest of this winter:

- Always assume GLA will be open unless you receive communication from us that we will be closed due to bad weather. We will notify families no later than 7am but usually, in practice, we will notify families much earlier.
- We typically follow Chicago Public Schools' decision on school closures. However, we reserve the right to make our own decision on whether we close or remain open.
- If you send students to school in snow boots, please send a pair of shoes in backpacks so students change once they get to school.
- When school is in session, we are required by law to take attendance. Attendance always counts when GLA is open.

Attendance typically slips in the winter. I know that travel is more challenging when the weather is cold or snowy <u>but it is important to make sure your child is here</u> <u>everyday</u>. Each day of absence means your child missed instructional time. This creates or adds to gaps in learning that build over time. Every day of attendance matters!
