


FAMILY SERIES

YEAR ROUND PROGRAMMING

Park Square offers six-week sessions of classes for kids grades K - 12 held on Saturdays at Park Square.

PARK SQUARE YOUTH COMPANY

A free after-school conservatory program for high school students with acting, playwriting, and technical theatre labs. SEPTEMBER - JUNE

SUMMER CAMPS

Nine weeks of Summer Camps for kids grades K- 12. Annually enrolling 600+ students.

Free student matinee performances of all our Main Stage productions are available for St. Paul Public School students. Discounted dates offered to students from various other schools and districts.

FLOOR REPLACEMENT \$30,000

With A Chorus Line and Goosebumps: The Musical on the horizon, we must restore and reinforce the Proscenium stage floor to support the high - energy movement and choreography these productions require. This project includes removing the worn masonite, repairing the subfloor and trap system, and installing a brand-new, durable show deck. A strong, stable stage is essential for performers, ensuring they can sing and dance safely without risk of injury. Your support will help create a professional, reliable foundation for every production.



SOUND SYSTEM UPGRADE \$31,000 (minimum) | \$80,000 (full upgrade)

Bringing *A Chorus Line* and *Goosebumps: The Musical* to life requires a critical upgrade to our wireless microphone and sound system. This investment includes permanent, high- quality wireless microphones, improved audio clarity, and the elimination of costly rentals, making productions more sustainable. *A Chorus Line* alone demands wireless microphones for 18 principal actors and 7 ensemble members to fully capture the show's intricate vocals and choreography. Your support ensures every performance sounds its best.
