Be sure to log your volunteer hours in your Entryeeze account. Remember each family needs 20 hours per year and each multi-skater family needs 30 hours.

Here's how

- 1. Log into your Entryeeze account on a laptop. This does not work on a phone.
- 2. Click on the "Volunteer" tab, then click "Volunteer Hours."
- 3. Click on your skater's name on the left, then enter your hours and a description. Even if another family member volunteered who is not a club member, you can still enter their hours under your skater's name.
- 4. Submit your hours

Volunteer Needs Spotlight

Looking for a way to get involved with FCFSC? We are looking for a couple of Committee Chairs for events we host. You might be a great fit!



Chair Openings—Competitions:

Hospitality Committee Chair: The committee chair Organizes and coordinates hospitality for a variety of club events, including competitions, club education, testing, and annual Ice Show. Committee responsibilities include coordinating catering orders, soliciting donations, hospitality set up and clean up, serving food, and occasionally shopping and/or cooking. This is such a fun committee and a great way to get to know other club members - training and support will be provided!

Setup/ Teardown: Assist with facility preparation and clean up during show week. This committee will set up and take down staging, props, curtains, quick change rooms, vendor/volunteer stations, and other facility needs prior to show. Availability to help after the final show is important. Committee help is primarily during Show Week.

Chair Openings— Show:

Costumes

Consult with coaches to assist them in selecting, organizing, ordering, and creating costumes for Learn-to-Skate (LTS) and tested skaters groups. Help with LTS skater measurements, fittings, alterations, and costume distribution. Assist parents of tested skaters develop/find costumes as needed. Facilitate costume approval by coaches for tested skaters. Time frame is mid-February (for LTS) through late March (for tested skater groups).

Props

Consult with coaches to assist them in designing and creating props and scenery, such as hats, canes, backdrops, and tables. Help build and/or purchase requested items within budget, problem-solve designs, and coordinate storage and use. Approximately 20 hours total between the end of February and late April.

Chair Openings— Show (cont.):

Music

Consult with coaches to select and edit music for show numbers. Previous experience cutting music is preferred. Time frame from mid-February to early March (music will be finished before rehearsals start).



Learn to Skate Outreach
