With construction completed, we took three weeks to get everything from storage into place and set up each new room the best we could. A generous gift allowed us to utilize more rooms than originally planned.

Our first board meeting in our new space was held on March 5 around the incredible new board meeting table made by the artisans at A Better Way Tables.

We hosted preview nights for volunteers and providers to see the new surroundings and a mock clinic provided the necessary assurance that we were ready for in-person clinics once again.

Doors re-opened on June 11 with three providers volunteering and 17 patients served. This day was even more special as the Mayor of Peachtree City proclaimed it "Ruth McCommon Day" in honor of our clinic founder. The proclamation reading was followed weeks later by a ribbon cutting with both the Fayette and Coweta Chambers.



Our Future

In accordance with our strategic plan, we are also developing a unique, robust, and engaging donor development plan that will increase overall donations by incorporating new and innovative ways to support our mission.

Our Expansion - Beginning in October 2024, we will add two Wednesday clinics to our monthly schedule. In January 2025, we will assess those clinics and determine if the two additional are sufficient or if we need to add one or more Wednesdays to our schedule. Of course, all added clinics require a baseline number of volunteers and staffing, so all added clinics are based on availability of volunteers.

We are working hard to increase the days and hours of operations, build a solid financial foundation, and expand our base by introducing ourselves to new counties, build partnerships with new churches, corporations, and communities.

We continue to build a volunteer base to support the growth of the clinic. We will deepen our relationships with local schools of nursing, area high schools, and others who want to join us on this journey. We want to provide an opportunity for any and all who have a desire to serve. Our regular monthly volunteer spotlights will recognize those who serve with us and also let others know who is on our team.

Our Future

Our partnership with Pro Bono Partners of Atlanta has allowed us to update bylaws, board policies, fiduciary policies, put an employee handbook in place, create an intern agreement, and allows us complete legal support at no charge.

We plan to celebrate our first 15 years of serving the community with an incredible event hosted at the Porsche Experience Center Atlanta. This event is created as an evening of fun, food, and speed. Attendees can ride with professional drivers, spend time in the simulation lab, and hear the history of many of the Porsches on display for the event. As we enter the third and final phase of our three-phase Expanding Possibilities Campaign, we will honor, not only those who supported our campaign with a wall plaque, but we will create a history wall highlighting various moments from our past.

As we welcome the next 15 years, we continue building a solid foundation so the Healing Bridge Clinic is here to serve for many years.

We are committed to honoring yesterday, focused on improving today, and excited about tomorrow's impact.
