World Honey Bee Day






The 3rd Saturday of every August is World Honey Bee Day. This year is celebrated on August 19th (my birthday!) The first world honey bee day was held in 2009 and has grown in popularity. The holiday is dedicated to beekeeping and to remind us of the beauty and value of bees.

Bee Facts:

- -A honeybee has 5 eyes: 2 large compound eyes with hexagonal facets & 3 small simple eyes
- -A fertile queen bee can lay up to 2,000 eggs per day
- The brain of a bee is the size of a sesame seed
- Bees pollinate food crops that supply around 90% of the world's food
- -Honeybee foraging statics show that a solitary bee can travel up to 10 miles for food

This Happened in August



Mother Teresa was born Agnes Gonzha Gojaxhiu on August 26, 1910, in Yugoslavia. She was an eminent social worker and missionary from India. From an early age she knew she would commit herself to a religious vocation. She left home at 18, never to see her family again, she joined a convent in Ireland. After learning English, she transferred to a convent in India. At 21, she took her nun vows and chose the Name Teresa. In Calcutta, she taught history and geography for daughters of the wealthy. She became distressed by the poverty she saw and after 15 years received permission to leave the order, while retaining her vows, to live and work among the poor. Mother Teresa started the Missions of Charity in 1950, a congregation dedicated to caring for "the hungry, the naked, the homeless, the crippled, the blind, the lepers, all those people who feel unwanted, unloved, uncared for throughout society, people that have become a burden to the society and are shunned by everyone". She won the Nobel peace price in 1979 and requested the cost of the ceremony \$192,000 to be given to the poor of India. She passed way at age 87 and was declared a Saint in 2016 by Pope Franics.






