Maybe it will be the start of a new daily trend of enjoying the outdoors away from our busy lives being connected. Go outside and enjoy your walk!

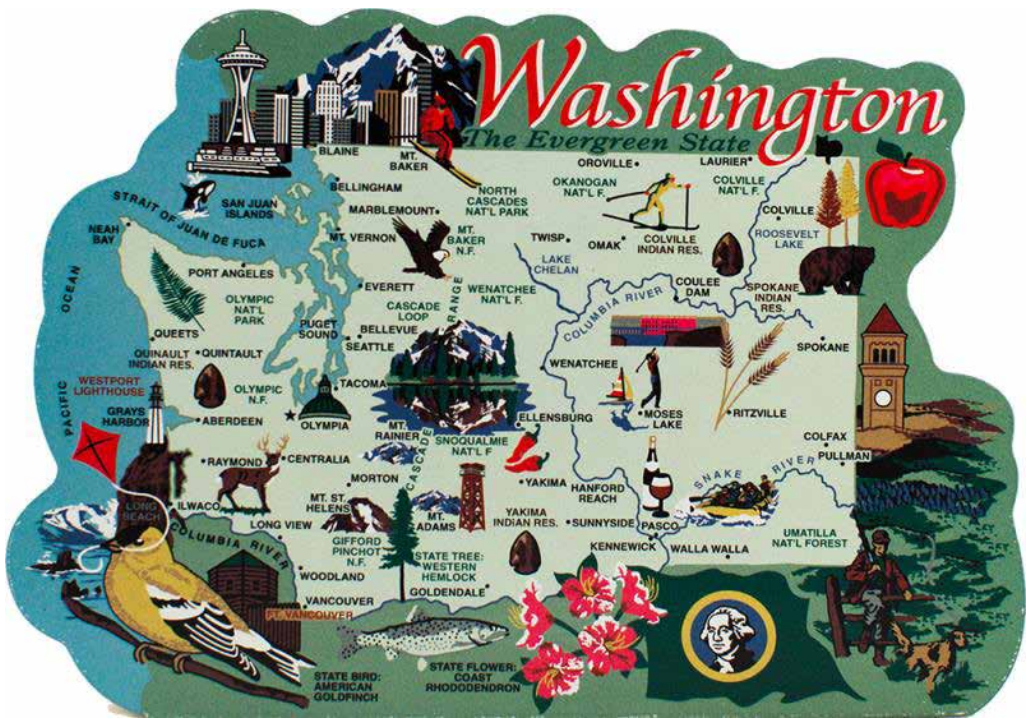

Do you Know your WA State Facts?

1. Washington was the 42nd state to enter the Union and is the only one named after a President
2. There are 10 volcanoes in Washington- Mt. Saint Helens erupted on May 18, 1980
3. Nicknamed the Evergreen state, more than 50% of the land is covered in forests
4. Boeing Airplanes was founded in the Seattle area in 1916 by William Boeing.
5. The Olympic peninsula is home to the only temperate rain forest in the lower 48 states – the Hoh Rainforest.
6. Tacoma has the world's largest totem pole. It is 105 feet high and was carved from a single cedar tree by a Native American sculptor brought from Alaska.
7. Cape Disappointment is one of the foggiest places in the U.S with 106 days of fog per year
8. The bass guitar concept and manufacturing started in the early 1930's. Paul Tutmarc of Seattle developed the first electric bass guitar in its modern form.

U.S. National Parks



This happened in March

The 18th President of the U.S., Ulysses S. Grant signed the bill creating the nation's first national park at Yellowstone on March 1, 1872. The Yellowstone Act of 1872 designated the region as “pleasuring-ground for the benefit and enjoyment of the people” which would be preserved “from injury or spoliation, of all timber, mineral deposits, natural curiosities, or wonders within.”

During the 1871 exploration of Yellowstone, the images provided by the pioneering photographer, Williams Jackson and brilliant landscape artist, Thomas Moran lead by government geologist Ferdinand Hayden caught the eye of the U.S. Congress. It was the first visual proof of the Yellowstone wonders.

With the signing of this bill, a precedent was set and popularized the idea of preserving sections of the public domain for use as public parks. On August 25, 1916, President Woodrow Wilson, 28th President of the U.S. signed the act creating the National Park Service.

The National Park System of the United States now comprises more than 400 areas covering more than 84 million acres. The most recent National Park added is New River Gorge in W. Virginia in December 2020.
