
Is it time to review your insurance coverages?




Fun Facts

Lightning bug vs firefly: Is it the same thing?



- Fireflies vs lightning bugs, which do you say? Turns out, it might depend on where you're from.
- In the South and Midwest, the parts of the country with the most lightning, they are frequently and almost exclusively referred to as lightning bugs. In the Northeast and West, they are called fireflies.
- Either way, they are the same bug. However, there are many various species of them. In fact, there are more than 2,000 firefly species and many share the same habitat.
- Did you know they talk to each other with light, their eggs glow, and they are found on almost every continent? The larvae also glows which is why they are often called glowworms. The glow is actually bioluminescence. It is a chemical reaction that creates energy. Even though a firefly's light is triggered by oxygen, fireflies do not have lungs. Instead, they inhale oxygen through tubes called "tracheoles."
- They imitate each other and the bug's flash can be yellow, green, or even blue!
- Fireflies are only about 1/2 inch long, and they have very big eyes to help see the flashes of other fireflies.
- Lightning bugs help to control garden pests like snails, slugs, cutworms, and aphids.
- Which team are you on? Team firefly or team lightning bug?
- Either way, as Shakespeare famously wrote, "a lightning bug by any other name would still have a glow-in-the-dark butt."
