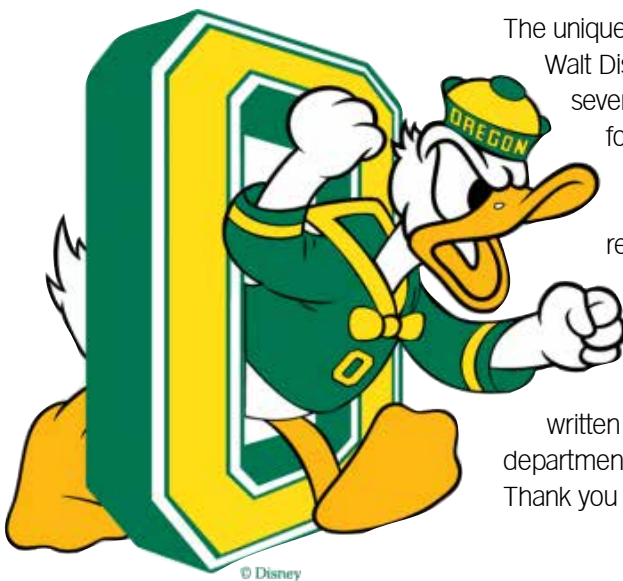




# This Happened in June

Donald Duck made his debut in "The Wise Little Hen," a Silly Symphony Cartoon on June 9th, 1934. This feisty and easily agitated yet lovable little sailor will forever be one of our favorites! Donald Duck appeared in comedic roles in animated cartoons.

While Donald Duck is a beloved Disney character it is also the mascot of the University of Oregon Ducks. The informal use of Ducks lasted until 1947, when the school's athletic director Leo Harris made a handshake deal with a close friend of his, Walt Disney, to allow the use of a likeness of Donald Duck as the school's mascot.



The unique deal stood for 20 years, with Walt Disney Productions providing several versions of the duck for Oregon's use, until the cartoonist's death in 1966. That's when both parties realized no formal contract existed granting the University the right to Donald's image. Disney representatives agreed to negotiate the first written contract in 1973 for the athletic department's continued use of Donald. Thank you Disney
