Do you Know your CA State Facts?

- The state of California has 36 area codes—the highest number in all of the United States. Texas comes in second place with 27 area codes.
- California is the only state in the country to have a chemical element named after it. Californium (Cf) is a rare earth metal and a biological hazard first discovered in the Golden State.
- Buried underneath San Francisco's
 Financial District, which was once
 the city's original shoreline, there
 are almost 40 sunken ships from
 the Gold Rush era. They were
 submerged because entire crews
 abandoned them and rushed into
 the towns and cities to seek their
 fortune.
- The Pacific Wheel at the Santa Monica Pier is the first and only solar-powered one in the world, featuring more than 174,000 LED lights.
- In 1984, L.A. became the only North American city to have hosted the Summer Olympic games twice, after hosting it for the first time in 1932.

- Come summer 2028, and the City of Angels will be hosting the event for the third time.
- Of all dog-friendly cities in the country, San Diego has the most dog-friendly restaurants per capita, in addition to the best parks and beaches.
- One of the most interesting facts about San Francisco is that the grizzly bear on the state flag once lived in Golden Gate Park. Monarch was one of the last of its kind to live in California.
- 8. The reconstructions of Sacramento that took place after the 1862 flood left portions of the city nine feet underground. The Sacramento History Museum takes visitors underground to learn about the unseen side of the city.
- California holds two of the top ten most popular cities: Los Angeles & San Diego.

Ellis Island Opened

The beginning of 1892 saw Ellis Island open and become one of the busiest immigration ports in the United States. The island was named after Samuel Ellis, who owned the land in the 1770s. Located in the New York Harbor between New York and New Jersey, it is a federally owned island. Originally the 3.3 acre island site was Fort Gibson then transformed into a naval magazine. President Benjamin Harrison designated Ellis Island as America's first federal immigration center in 1890. Prior to that immigration was handled at the state level.

On January 1, 1896, Ellis Island opened to process and inspect almost 12 million immigrants from around the world. Annie Moore, a 15-year-old from Ireland was the first person to processed. Fire destroyed the first inspection station in 1897 and was rebuilt and reopened in 1900 with additional facilities. By the 1930s, the island had been expanded to its current size of 27.5 acres using landfill. The busiest year of operation was 1907 with over 1 million people processed. The Immigration Act of 1924 reduced the number of immigrants as well as allowing for processing at US consulates aboard. Ellis Island was then used as a detention center during both World Wars. On November 12, 1954, Ellis Island closed its doors after releasing the last war detainee, a Norwegian merchant seaman.

in 1984, Ellis Island was renovated costing \$160 million in the largest historic restoration project in US history. In September 1990, the Ellis Island Immigration Museum opened and is visited today by nearly 2 million people a year. If you find yourself in New York, check it out!
