History of the Red Poppy



Memorial Day is a day to remember those who lost their lives fighting for our country. In appreciation and remembrance of these men and women many of us nationally and internationally wear a red poppy.



Ever wonder where the red poppy came from?

In 1915 a 22 year old man of the Canadian Artillery was killed by a German gunman. His Lieutenant colonel and friend wrote "Flanders Field", a now famous poem, to display on his grave. In response to "Flanders Fields" Moina Michael wrote her own poem that same year.

We cherish too, the Poppy red That grows on fields where valor led, It seems to signal to the skies That blood of heroes never dies.



She was the first to wear one, and sold poppies to her friends and co-workers with the money going to benefit servicemen in need. Later, Madam Guerin from France made artificial red poppies to raise money for war orphaned children and widowed women.

Shortly before Memorial Day in 1922 the

VFW became the first veterans' organization to nationally sell poppies. Two years later their "Buddy" Poppy program was selling artificial poppies made by disabled veterans, to honor and remember the men and women who died for our country.
