



SELF-ACCESS REHEARSAL POLICY WITH NO CHARGE

When do I book my rehearsal date & time?

- You will have the ability to schedule your 1-hour self-access rehearsal when we meet for your final walkthrough or at any point 30 days prior to your wedding.

How do I access the venue?

- You will not have indoor access to the Barn, only to your outdoor ceremony site.

Can I bring food and drink to my rehearsal?

- No food and no alcoholic beverages are permitted at your rehearsal.

Can I bring items for my event to the rehearsal and leave them in the venue overnight?

- No items can be left at the venue overnight or brought in any time before your event access.

What time can I book my rehearsal?

- We'll check the calendar at your 30-day final walkthrough, and you can book whatever is available at that time. Most couples schedule a morning rehearsal followed by lunch or brunch so they can have the rest of the day and evening to take care of loose ends or rest. Please note, if we have an event the day prior to your event, rehearsal will need to be scheduled no later than 9:30am. The latest you can schedule a rehearsal time is 4:00pm.

Will there be a Barn Staff Coordinator onsite during my rehearsal?

- No, unless a special request is made. An hourly rate of \$150 will be assessed and deducted from the refundable security deposit if you want indoor access and a Barn Staff Coordinator on site.

Can I test the in-house sound system, mic, and/or slide show at the rehearsal?

- No. If you need music for the rehearsal, we suggest you bring a Bluetooth portable speaker. If you want to test the in-house sound system or slideshow prior to your event, it will need to be done at your final walk through.

Who runs the rehearsal?

- Your day of coordinator and/or officiant will be responsible for conducting the rehearsal. There will not be a Barn Coordinator on site for a self-access rehearsal.
