This School Program Book explains our programs, curriculums, standards, staff, FAQ and the application process.

What are your hours? We are open Monday – Friday from 7:00 am – 6:00 pm


What ages do you serve? We have childcare and preschool year-round for infants- 5 years of age. We also offer after school care, vacation care and a summer camp for children ages 3-7.

What schedules do you offer? Children may attend 2-5 days a week. You may choose the days your child attends on a set schedule/

School Closings: We are closed for major holidays and staff training days per year. A complete calendar is in the school handbook and on our website.

Are you licensed or affiliated? We are licensed by the NJ Department of Children and Families. We are affiliated with NAEYC and follow their guidelines for developmentally appropriate practices. We also participate in the Grow NJ Kids certification.

Are your staff members educated and trained? Our staff members and teachers are educated and experienced in early childhood education and development. Many hold college degrees and / or CDAs. Monthly training is conducted across a broad range of topics for all staff members.

Are children of different ages grouped together? Children are grouped into classes based upon their age and developmental level. Children of various ages do come together for special events, parties, trips and opening and closing periods.

Do you welcome parent involvement; can I stop by unannounced? The answer is "YES!" Our school is a community that is open and encourages family participation. We host events throughout the year, including parties, trips, special guest visitors and more! Parents can be involved in many ways.

How do you communicate with parents? Our primary mode of communication is through our school app. All families are enrolled in the program and daily activities, messages, newsletters, and reminders are sent to families via our school app. Families may also send us messages on the school app. Additionally, there are bulletin boards, daily notes, and postings on our social media sites.

How often do you clean the rooms and equipment? All our facilities (including toys) are cleaned multiple times a day. The bathrooms and the changing tables are disinfected continuously over the course of the day.

What are your health policies? In NJ, a complete health assessment form by the child's primary care provider is required. It is the parent's responsibility to maintain current health and immunization records. To keep our children, their families, and our staff, as healthy as possible, we require that any child with a fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or contagious disease be kept at home.

Do you have a playground, is there daily outside time?

We have a playground on the side of our building. The playground is fenced in for security. In addition to free play, we conduct learning experiences outside on a regular basis. (Weather permitting.)



Do you have STEM & technology tools?

We are proud to offer STEM and technology tools in our program. We introduce Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) through fun, hands-on activities designed for curious little minds. Our goal is to spark creativity, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills in an age-appropriate way.

What security measures are in place to protect my child? Your child's safety and your peace of mind are of the utmost concern. Our entire facility is locked from the outside and the play yard is fenced in. We have automatic smoke and fire detection alarms, and all staff have criminal background checks, fingerprinting, and emergency preparedness training.

How is tuition paid? We are happy to offer our families a childcare software program for easy autopay service. Tuition is paid monthly though your bank/checking accounts, this prevents late payments and late fees! Enrollment is simple to do and is FREE! All families are required to use this program.

Who provides meals and snacks? Families provide all meals and snacks for their children. We do offer a daily lunch that may be purchased from neighborhood restaurants.

Is potty training a requirement? Your child DOES NOT have to be potty trained. Preschool admission is not based upon this skill. All children develop at their own pace. Staff members will help parents when it is time to train, and a positive training plan will be implemented!



What is your admissions and EOE policy?

Tiny Signs – Baby Sign Language

At Kidz Campus, we incorporate *Tiny Signs*, a baby sign language program, into our infant and toddler curriculum. Signing helps babies express their needs before they can speak, leading to:

- Advanced language development and stronger vocabulary.
- Higher cognitive abilities, with research showing higher average IQs.
- A deeper connection between caregiver and child as we better understand their interests and personality.

Our Preschool & Prekindergarten Curriculum

Our curriculum is designed to ensure that children acquire measurable learning objectives across the year that are developmentally appropriate for three-year old to five-year old. The learning objectives are broken down into specific, measurable, and sequential skills that are incorporated into the curriculum. Specific skills and concepts are targeted on a weekly and monthly basis in a fun and engaged manner.



Each baby is cared for based upon their unique needs, a schedule will be developed through parent / teacher planning so that your baby is well rested, fed, and loved!

The Caregivers

Our staff is focused on keeping your baby happy, engaged, and secure. Your baby will have 1-2 primary caregivers. There are also always teaching assistants and directors on site if extra TLC is required.

Your Baby's Day

Each baby is cared for based upon their unique schedule and needs. Every day has a varied amount of quiet time, rest time, play time, and learning time. Amber H. Could not be happier with our experience in the infant room so far! Our daughter is 6 months old and has been attending for a few weeks. Communication with staff has been great and we love the daily picture updates they send. Our daughter always seems happy and well cared for, which has made my transition back to work much easier. Communication & Care

Every day your baby's caregivers will record their learning activities, their sleep schedule, diaper and eating activity. You will also be informed of your baby's. mood and any concerns such as teething or changing food preferences. The teachers will let you know any needed items; when it is time to restock diapers, change of clothes or any other personal needs.

Bright Baby's Learning & Development

Every day, your baby will have the opportunity to learn and develop through age-appropriate activities and experiences. The nursery, in addition to having rest and feeding areas, also has several learning areas devised just for the babies in our care. Every day, your baby will have the following:
