

Before Starting the Project Listings for the CoC Priority Listing

The grant recipient, United Way of Weld County (UWWC), is voluntarily reallocating a portion of their DV-Coordinated Entry project that is no longer required to support our CoC's coordinated entry administration due to securing other funding in favor to expand a DV-specific RRH project to serve more survivors of domestic violence with housing. Though UWWC voluntarily reduced their grant on a previously agreed upon amount, they were still formally notified of the reduction on 10/10/2024.





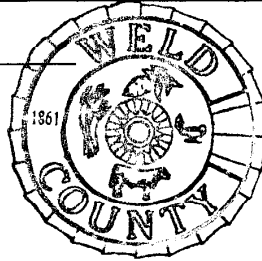
