# Competition Overview

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1. Housing & Urban Development (HUD) method to allocate regional funding to address homelessness.
2. Consolidated Application – Prepared & submitted by Collaborative Applicant
  - Local Competition, Project Rating Process
  - CoC Application
  - Priority Listing
3. If funded, project applicants will contract directly with HUD, not with Collaborative Applicant



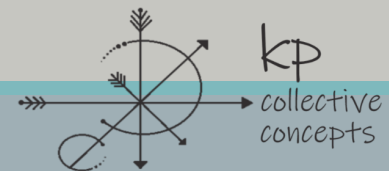

## Funding Available

- **Annual Renewal Demand (ARD)** – The total amount of all the CoC’s projects that will be eligible for renewal in the CoC Program Competition
- **Pro Rata Need (PRN)** – The total amount that the CoC region could theoretically spend based on population
- **CoC Bonus** – Up to 12% of Final Pro Rata Need (FPRN) to create one or more new project applications
- **DV Bonus** – Up to 15% of Preliminary Pro Rata Need (PPRN) for new DV Bonus eligible projects
  - Must 100% be dedicated to serving victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, and/or stalking; Applicant does not have to be a traditional victim service provider to apply
- **Tier 1** – 90% of ARD
- **Tier 2** – Remainder of ARD plus applicable CoC Bonus and DV Bonus

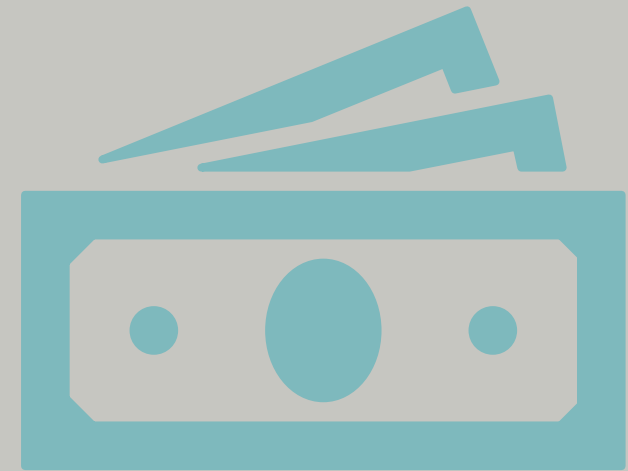


# Competition Overview

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## Types of Projects

- **Renewal** – Projects that currently receive CoC funding
- **Expansion** – Projects that currently receive CoC funding but are seeking additional CoC funding to add units/services to serve more people
- **New** – Projects that are seeking CoC funding for an existing program or for a brand-new program
  - Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)
  - Rapid Rehousing (RRH)
  - Joint Transitional Housing-Rapid Rehousing (Joint TH-RRH)
  - HMIS Lead
  - Coordinated Entry
  - Domestic Violence Bonus - Rapid Rehousing or Coordinated Entry only
- **Reallocation** – funding from previously awarded CoC project to be moved from one project to fund a new or expansion project



# Rating & Ranking Process

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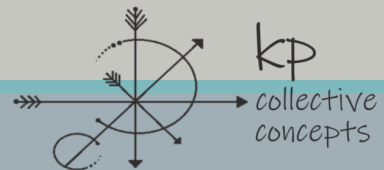


## Local Competition –

- CoC's must conduct a “local process” to evaluate projects seeking CoC funding in relation to project performance, project commitment to Housing First and other best practices, and project alignment with local [CoC priorities](#)
- Local “CoC Rating Application” will be filled out by applicants and then reviewed and rated on specific factors by the CoC Rating Committee;
- projects will be ranked based on score onto the Priority Listing

## Priority Listing –

- Official funding ranking order submitted to HUD for NoCO CoC project applicant
- Tier I = 90% of available funding, non-competitive
- Tier II = Remainder of available funding + Bonus, very competitive

Tier 2 = \$311,798

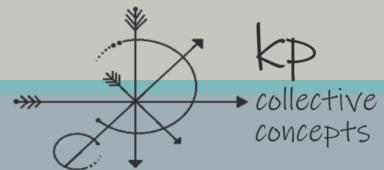

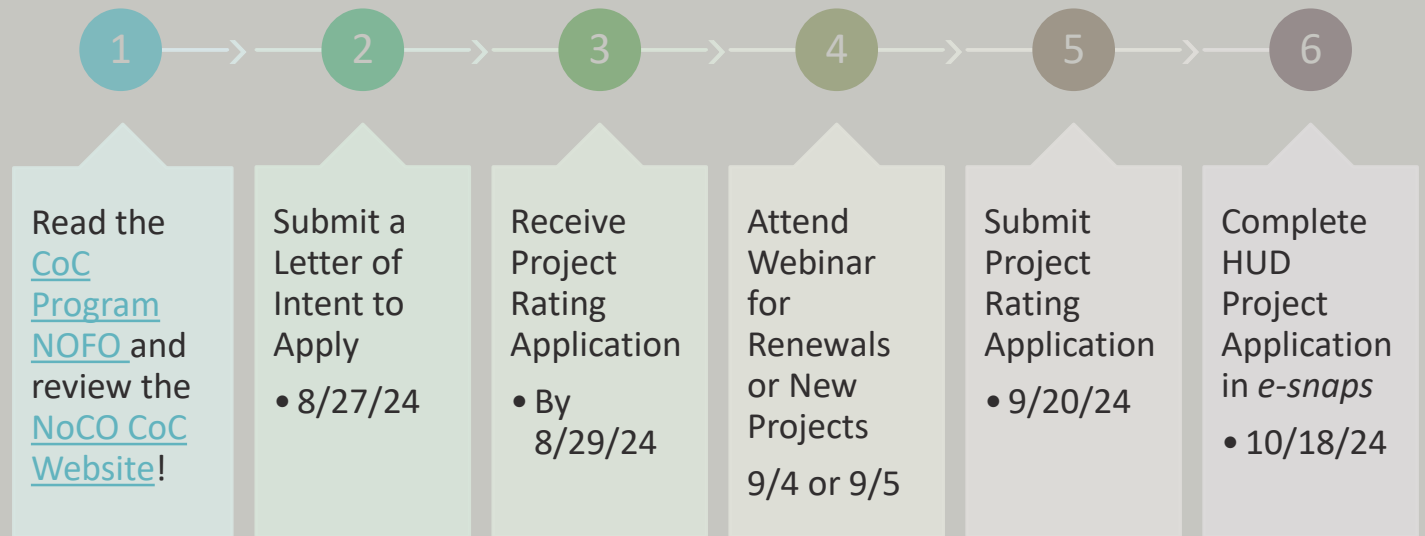

# HUD Scoring Process

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## Consolidated Application

- CoC's must submit a "CoC Application" alongside the individual Project Applications
- Detailing a wide range of activities, strategies, and outcomes that the CoC has engaged in to address homelessness across the whole region
- CoC Application is scored and ranked against all other CoCs
- Ranking of CoC Application impacts the funding available for individual Project Applications

## Project Funding Decisions

- Tier I = 90% of available funding, non-competitive
- Tier II = Remainder of available funding + Bonus, very competitive
- Projects in Tier II are funded in order of ranking on Priority Listing, based on combination of CoC Application score and the amount of money available
- Decisions made usually early Spring, contract directly with HUD not the CoC
