## NoCO CoC-Wide Prioritization Updates



To guide the NoCO CoC's regional work to address homelessness, it is necessary to outline a set of CoC-wide priorities to help direct funding, strategy and advocacy in a meaningful way. These priorities are reviewed annually by the NoCO CoC Governing Board and updated as needed. A CoC-Wide Prioritization Guidance outlining the types of projects and populations to primarily focus efforts is an important tool to fund the work, set regional and local strategy, and advocate for homelessness solutions.

### **Coordinated Assessment Housing Placement System (CAHPS)**

CAHPS is the community-driven process to identify, assess, refer, and house all people experiencing homelessness in Weld and Larimer Counties.

**Since 2016, the CAHPS process has helped house 1,981 households.**

Through CAHPS, the NoCO CoC is participating in the [Community Solutions Built for Zero Initiative](#) to reach Functional Zero to end Veteran and Chronic homelessness.
