


The NoCO CoC is hiring immediately for two positions working with our Coordinated Assessment Housing Placement System (CAHPS).

Our goal is to provide grants to support local governments and non-profit organizations in the state of Colorado, with ESG and Proposition 123 Prop 123 funds allocated towards a range of eligible activities, including street outreach, emergency shelters, homelessness prevention, rapid re-housing, administrative activities, and data collection through the Homeless Management Information Systems (HMIS) or the HMIS comparable database, known as the Client Assessment, File, and Event system (CAFÉ).

Coordinated Assessment Housing Placement System (CAHPS)

CAHPS is the community-driven process to identify, assess, refer, and house all people experiencing homelessness in Weld and Larimer Counties.

Since 2016, the CAHPS process has helped house 1,700 households.

Through CAHPS, the NoCO CoC is participating in the <u>Community Solutions</u> <u>Built for Zero Initiative</u> to reach Functional Zero to end Veteran and Chronic homelessness.
