Veteran Functional Zero: Shifts Are Happening!

Due to the collective efforts of our CoC CAHPS partners, there have been significant strides in our commitment to ending veteran homelessness and we have the data to prove it!

Our total number of actively homeless veterans is at a record low: 41 (as of 10/31/2024 compared to 68 on 4/30/2024) 24 unique households have been housed since September!

Resource Highlight: Eviction Prevention Toolkit and Webinar Recording

Eviction Prevention: Toolkit for Tenants and Service Providers

This toolkit is for people with mental health conditions, substance use disorders, or cooccurring disorders living in communitybased low-income housing and the service providers and organizations supporting them in their housing and recovery. The toolkit provides essential information to support stable tenancies and avoid the trauma of housing eviction. Toolkit topics include upstream eviction prevention strategies, housing support services, landlord partnerships, and more.

Coordinated Assessment Housing Placement System (CAHPS)

CAHPS is the community-driven process to identify, assess, refer, and house all people experiencing homelessness in Weld and Larimer Counties.

Since 2016, the CAHPS process has helped house over 2,000 households.

Through CAHPS, the NoCO CoC is participating in the <u>Community</u> <u>Solutions Built for Zero Initiative</u> to reach Functional Zero to end Veteran and Chronic homelessness.
