Resource Digest: United for ALICE

We all know people who are ALICE:

Asset Limited, **I**ncome **C**onstrained, **E**mployed — earning more than the Federal Poverty Level, but not enough to afford the basics where they live.

ALICE households and households in poverty are forced to make tough choices, such as deciding between quality child care or paying the rent — choices that have long-term

Of Colorado's 2,357,045 households in 2022...

- 9% earned below the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
- 28% were ALICE, in households that earned above the FPL but not enough to afford the basics in the

consequences not only for their families, but for all.

United For ALICE calculates the cost of household essentials for all counties in Colorado. These costs, outlined in the [Household Survival Budget](#), are calculated for various household sizes and compositions.

- Together, 37% of households in Colorado were below the ALICE Threshold (poverty + ALICE divided by total households)
