Products: Deep Clean / Grout Prep / Grout Color Sealer / Enhanced Prep Pad / Haze Remover Pad / Tile Seal Surfaces: Ceramic, Porcelain, Quarry Tile



Preparation and Grout Evaluation

1. Repair Missing Grout:

- Larger areas of missing grout must be repaired at least 48 hours before starting the NeverStrip Tile and Grout Restoration procedure.
- Use a fast-drying, pre-mixed sanded grout product for small repairs during the restoration process.

2. Do Not Use Grout Color Sealer If:

- Grout is epoxy.
- Grout is even with or higher than the tile surface.
- The Tile has lippage (uneven edges).
- Flooring is made of porous natural stone.

Cleaning and Surface Preparation

1. Initial Grout Cleaning and Testing:

- Clean a small section of sanded grout.
- Pour undiluted **Grout Prep** onto the grout:
 - If it turns white and bubbles/fizzes, the product is working.
 - If no reaction occurs, investigate the blockage (e.g., sealer, coating, floor finish, or organic matter).
- Removal Options:
 - Floor Finish: Use a high-quality stripper and uneven floor brush (NeverStrip offers these tools).
 - **Organic Matter:** Remove with NeverStrip Deep Clean and uneven grout brush. Grout saws may be necessary in difficult areas.
 - Sealer/Coating: Strip the floor and grout lines thoroughly.
 - Epoxy Grout: Do not use the Grout Color Sealer.

2. Deep Cleaning:

- Mix **16 oz. of <u>NeverStrip Deep Clean</u>** per gallon of water.
- Apply liberally to the floor and let it dwell for **15 minutes**.
- Scrub using a floor machine with an uneven tile and grout brush.
- Extract slurry, rinse with water, and ensure the floor is completely dry.

3. Grout Prep Application:

• Repeat the deep cleaning process using <u>NeverStrip Grout Prep</u>.

4. Final Rinse:

- Rinse the floor with water mixed with 2 oz. of NeverStrip Deep Clean per gallon.
- Let the solution dwell for **5 minutes** and extract thoroughly.

Grout Color Sealing

1. Grout Color Sealer Application:

- For non-epoxy grout only.
- Ensure all grout lines are properly repaired and cleaned beforehand.

2. Application Based on Tile Size:

- Tiles Smaller than 4" x 4":
 - Apply <u>Color Sealer</u> to a 2' x 2' area using a pint/quart bottle with a Yorker cap.
 - Mist water lightly on the area.
 - Spread the sealer with the NeverStrip White Color Sealer Applicator Pad.
 - Wait 1-2 minutes, then wipe excess from the tile surface with a clean, damp chamois cloth at a 45-degree angle to the grout lines. Repeat as needed.
- Tiles 4" x 4" or Larger:
 - Cut the Yorker cap to match grout line width.
 - Apply a thin bead of Color Sealer to the grout lines.
 - Spread with a Large Tile Applicator Brush and remove excess sealer with a damp chamois cloth.
- 3. Drying Time: Allow the Color Sealer to dry for 30 minutes before proceeding.

Final Steps

Haze Removal:

- Lightly mist water on the tile.
- Use a NeverStrip Enhanced Prep Pad or Maroon X Restoration Pad with a 175 rpm floor machine to remove haze.
- For remaining haze, repeat the process with a **NeverStrip Haze Removal Pad**.

Main Application

- Apply 2-3 coats of <u>Tile Seal</u> on ceramic, porcelain, and quarry tile: Two coats are sufficient if the sealer's appearance is attractive.
- Spread rate: 5,000 6,000 sq. feet per gallon per application on non-porous surfaces (first application may cover less).

Application methods:

Use a quality **Microfibre Spray Mop Applicator** (using **this method**) or a standard garden pump sprayer with a dripless brass tip.

Pre-dampen the microfibre pad with the sealer before application.

- If using a pump sprayer, spray just ahead of spreading.
- Avoid too much product; if the product appears white, it is over-applied.
- Avoid "playing" with the sealer too much.
- Spread product onto adjoining sections by a couple of inches to avoid skips.
- Allow 10-15 minutes for drying before applying the next coat or resuming typical commercial traffic.
- Allow 25 minutes of dry time before burnishing.

Post-Application Care:

- Keep water off the floor for 8 hours.
- During the first week, clean marks/scuffs with Micron Clean (2 oz./gallon) and a red pad. Burnish for best results.
