Introduction

VCT achieved large market share due to its simplicity, superior strength, durability. low product cost and multi-decade useful life. VCT is often referred to as a 30-year floor.

A core reason VCT was so successful was its symbiotic relationship with Floor Finish.

VCT lost market share to LVT and other flooring partly due to the high life cycle cost of ownership resulting from the intensive maintenance of Floor Finish based floor care.

The core strategy to revive and grow VCT is to lower ongoing care costs.

NeverStrip introduced its INNOVATIVE, MICRON SEALERS DURING 2012.



Micron Sealers allow VCT to have the benefits of LVT, which is the non-wax top coat, which never requires stripping, therefore lowering the lifecycle cost of VCT ownership.

The VCT Micron Sealer floor care paradigm has been proven since 2012 by North American Starnet and FUSE Alliance Floor Care Maintenance Members, other floor care maintenance contractors and facility end users.



Why Was VCT with Floor Finish Based Floor Care Successful for So Long?

- Low oil prices kept Floor Finish costs low.
- Floor care labor, including Baby Boomers with experience, was widely available.
- · Floor care labor costs were low.
- Sustainability was not a priority within many geographic markets. Floor Finish based floor care is **not** sustainable: 1) Floor Finish requires large quantities of water and electricity to maintain; 2) Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs), especially from strippers, generate substantial indoor air pollution and 3) Floor Finish/Stripper Sludge has continuously gone down drains or into landfills.
- LVT and other alternatives were not the significant competitor as they are now.
- Alternative floor care systems for VCT were not available, affordable or practical for a host of reasons (costs, dry times, odors, specialized skills, expensive equipment, etc.).
- The floor care industry channel participants have resisted change to the Floor Finish floor care model. Multi-billion dollar Floor Finish manufacturers; Jan San Distributors and Floor Care Maintenance Contractors have had little to no interest replacing/innovating the VCT floor care gravy train with its relentless cycle of apply, strip, apply, strip, apply, strip.



What Changed With Floor Finish Based Floor Care In the Last Decade?

- Material costs have risen sharply.
- There is now a huge shortage of floor care workers. The skilled Boomer personnel are retiring. Younger generations do not want to do floor care work.
- · Floor care labor costs have risen significantly.
- Sustainability is now a priority. Stripping is viewed as a "Bad" practice.
- Micron Floor Care is now an accepted, proven floor care system, which lowers the life cycle cost of ownership.

VCT: A Low Cost or High Cost Floor?

VCT is a Low Cost floor at installation.

VCT has a High Life Cycle Cost of Ownership maintained with floor finish.

VCT High Life Cycle Cost of Ownership is largely due to the substantial labor costs required to maintain a Floor Finish Based System. The industry Rule of Thumb is Floor Finish based floor care costs are 80% labor and 20% products.

The key to lowering VCT Life Cycle Cost of Ownership is to reduce the floor care costs.

The key to lowering floor care costs is to reduce labor hours.

Micron Sealers rquire less labor to maintain.
