The below information is to increase your knowledge about the skin biopsy procedure that was performed today for Epidermal Nerve Fiber Density (ENFD) testing.

Why did my physician perform the ENFD test?

Based on your symptoms consistent with neuropathy, the ENFD test has been performed to determine if you have small fiber neuropathy. This test will provide objective evidence to obtain a definitive diagnosis and assist your provider in recommending appropriate treatment.

Who is NextGenomix Laboratories?

NextGenomix Laboratories is an in-network Molecular/histopathology laboratory, located in Norcross, Georgia, specializing in Genetics and ENFD testing. Cases are read by board-certified anatomic pathologists with specialized training and certifications in Neurology and Dermatopathology; focused expertise on analyzing small fiber specimens.

When will the results of the ENFD test be available?

Your provider will receive the skin biopsy report within 10-14 days from the procedure date. A follow-up appointment after this time-frame should be made with your provider to review the results.

Does insurance pay for ENFD testing?

Insurance covers ENFD testing in most cases. An Explanation of Benefits (EOB) will be sent to you after the after the biopsy has been analyzed by the laboratory to explain processing of the claim.
