1. Spectator Conduct:

3. Post-Game Behavior:

- Carry positive energy and sportsmanship into the parking area. Avoid confrontations or negative discussions after the game.

4. Athlete Behavior:

- Athletes are expected to treat each other, coaches, and officials with respect.
- Physical aggression, threats, and discrimination will not be tolerated.
- Theft, including stealing from others or the facility, is strictly prohibited.

5. Supervision of Athletes under 10:
