Why Attend the Summit?

A Message from our Founder

The Knowledge Shop is a non-profit organization based in South Los Angeles. In 2015 we began offering after-school programs to local students because they were struggling with their homework, particularly in math. At the time, my daughter had graduated from high school as a high achiever in math, so I wondered why other Black students were not thriving in math in district schools. This was followed by the adoption of new Common Core Math Standards that entailed changes in how math was taught in schools. The early SBAC scores showed major racial disparities in math. I wondered why White and Asian students were doing so well with Common Core but not our **Black and Brown students!**

To help answer this question, we decided with two of our partners, the [Parent Organization Network](#) and [High Expectations](#), to study the role of families in math education in California. Since the publication of our report, '[Teacher-Family Partnerships Empower Math Students](#)', we have been sharing our work with educators, policymakers, and, most importantly, our Black and Brown students and families. We believe in our research and have created this summit bringing them all to Downtown Los Angeles where we have presentations from **expert** policymakers, educators, parents, and students from across California. Partners are also coming to show why we use their products and programs over others--their use of *culturally sustaining pedagogy, neuroscience, and artificial intelligence* to teach math to Black and Brown students.

It's all under one roof on Saturday, April 29th from 7:30 am - 5:30 pm. Breakfast, lunch, and snacks will be provided.
