## REGISTERED BREEDING SHEEP

### Rules:

1. Identification program see State Rule X #1 Sheep & Goat Health Rules.
2. All State and local rules apply.
3. Registry in appropriate associations is required for entry.
4. Flock numbers shall be used to identify all entries. Numbers shall be on regular and practical tags attached to the ear or tattooed in the ear for Yearlings and Lambs bred by the exhibitor, except for National Suffolk Sheep Association; in which case their registration ID requirements will be followed.
5. If there is a sufficient number of any one breed in the "All Other Breeds" Division, a separate division may be established.
6. Ewes entered in the market lamb divisions may not be entered in the breeding divisions or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the Fair.

Use the division number to designate breed. Use the same class numbers listed below for all divisions.

**DIVISION 750** 4-H & FFA SMALL MEAT BREEDS (CHEVIOT, SOUTHDOWN, ALL OTHER SMALL MEAT)

**DIVISION 751** 4-H & FFA LARGE MEAT BREEDS (SUFFOLK, HAMPSHIRE, DORSET AND ALL OTHER LARGE MEAT)

### Class

7. Young Flock: One ram lamb and two ewe lambs.
8. Pair of Yearling Ewes: Two yearling ewes.
9. Pair of Ram Lambs: Two ram lambs.
10. Pair of Ewe Lambs: Two ewe lambs.
11. Flock: One yearling or ram lamb, two yearling ewes, and two ewe lambs.
12. Get of Sire: Four sheep sired by the same ram.

## WHETHER DAM –WHETHER SIRE (UNREGISTERED)

Limit: 2 Entries Per Class Per Exhibitor

### Rules:

1. Identification program see State Rule X #1 Sheep & Goat Health Rules.
2. A permanent ear tag or tattoo is required.
3. Animals cannot be entered or shown in the registered classes.
4. All state and local rules apply.
5. Ewes entered in the market lamb divisions may not be entered in the breeding divisions or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the Fair.

**DIVISION 753** \_\_\_\_\_ FFA & 4-H WHETHER DAM –WHETHER SIRE SHEEP

### Class

1. Ewes... all lambs will be weighed during weigh-ins and split into classes by weight.
2. Rams... all lambs will be weighed during weigh-ins and split into classes by weight.
