**JUDGING: American and open to Public**

**RIBBONS for First, Second and Third places**

**Eligibility for GRAND EXHIBITOR placing, NO CASH PRIZE, ROSETTES ONLY:** To qualify for Grand Exhibitor you must compete in at least 3 (three) divisions in this department. The top three overall scores within the department will qualify for a first, second and third place. If there are not enough qualified Exhibitors to fill all three placings, only the highest places will be awarded. There is no fee, and no separate entry for Grand Exhibitor. It is calculated and awarded automatically based on highest overall scores.

**PEOPLE’S CHOICE AWARD:** Fair goers visiting Expo Hall between Fair Open on Thursday, August 24, 2023 and Noon on Sunday, August 27, 2023 are eligible to cast their vote for their favorite exhibit. At 12:30PM on Sunday, August 27, 2023, all votes will be tallied, and the People’s Choice Award given.

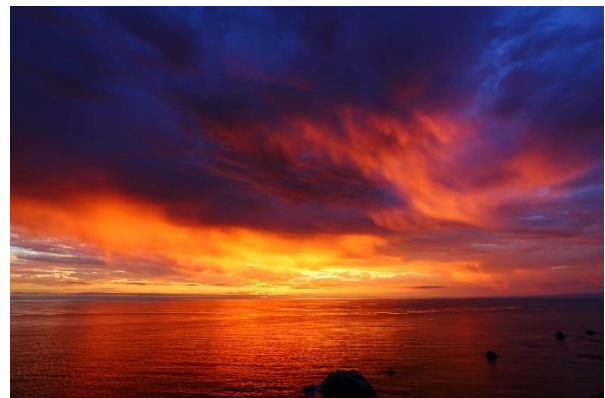

### **PLEASE FOLLOW THESE PHOTOGRAPHY ENTRY TIPS:**

1. Photo size minimum is 8x10", with a maximum of 16x20", exception to size is selfies mounted on mat board
2. Photos must be mounted on a mat board or in a mat frame. Maximum mat size is 20x24". Mat must be securely attached. No framed prints (metal, wood or other than mat board)
3. No photograph of identical subject matter may be entered (two versions/same picture)
4. Do not label with name on front of photograph. Any names will be covered by Fair Staff in order to facilitate "blind" judging
5. You may label your name in the upper lefthand corner of the back of the entry showing Name, address, phone, Division, Class and Title of photo.
