Rules:

- 1. One dog per exhibitor.
- 2. Exhibitors may only enter showmanship.
- 3. State and Local rules apply. Official uniforms must be worn.
- 4. Exhibitors only may groom and handle dogs. Adults may assist in the loading and unloading.
- 5. Bitches in season will not be allowed.
- 6. Uncontrolled or aggressive dogs will be dismissed and must immediately be removed from the Fairgrounds.
- 7. A six-foot leash is required for rally obedience classes. Flat Collar, Martingale, or Slip Collar are acceptable.

NO PRONG or PINCH COLLAR

- 8. All dogs must be current on their shots: DHLPP and rabies. A copy of their proof of shots must be sent in.
- 9. American system of judging. State and Local Rules apply.
- 10. Dogs need to be removed from the grounds after the show is over or unless asked to be used for Round Round.

DIVISION 885 RALLY OBEDIENCE

Class

- **1. PRIMARY** Open to all youth exhibitors aged 5-8 years of age.
- **2. NOVICE** Open to exhibitors who have NEVER competed in Rally Obedience before. Novice will follow all AKC novice guidelines, all exercises are performed on a six (6) foot leash.
- **3. ADVANCED** Open to exhibitors who HAVE competed in rally obedience competitions, either AKC, B Match, or local fairs. Advanced follows AKC Novice guidelines and may include off-leash work.

DOG SHOWMANSHIP

One Entry Only Must enter online

Rules:

- 1. Exhibitors must show their own dogs, entry in an obedience class is not required.
- 2. If an exhibitor places 1st in their respective showmanship division they can choose to move up to the next division immediately following the current division. If they choose to move up a division and win said division, they must represent that division. They can not go back down and represent a lower division. However if they do not win said division, then the exhibitor will represent the lower division.
- 3. First place winners in Junior, Senior and FFA will compete in Master Showmanship on August 26. Exhibitors will be required to bring their showmanship animal for the Master Showmanship.
- 4. American system of judging, ribbons for placings $1^{st} 8^{th}$ only. No premiums.
- 5. State and Local rules apply. See showmanship pages for further information.
- 6. Age of exhibitor as of January 1 of current show year.
- 7. Exhibitors must enter showmanship online.
- 8. All exhibitors are required to wear the official show uniform as listed in the Additional Junior Department Rules and Local Livestock Rules.
