JUDGING: American and open to Public

Eligibility for GRAND EXHIBITOR placing, ROSETTES: To qualify for Grand Exhibitor you must compete in at least 3 (three) divisions in this department. The top three overall scores within the department will qualify for a first, second and third place. If there are not enough qualified Exhibitors to fill all three placings, only the highest places will be awarded. There is no fee, and no separate entry for Grand Exhibitor. It is calculated and awarded automatically based on highest overall scores.

PEOPLE’S CHOICE AWARD: Fair goers visiting Expo Hall between Fair Open on Thursday, August 22, 2023 and Noon on Sunday, August 25, 2023 are eligible to cast their vote for their favorite exhibit. At 12:30PM on Sunday, August 25, 2023, all votes will be tallied, and the People’s Choice Award given.

ADULT & YOUTH CRAFTS, HOME & INDUSTRIAL ARTS RULES:

1. All exhibits in this department must not have been shown at any previous Butte County Fair
2. Fragile or unstable items may be eliminated if it is difficult to properly display
3. All names or personal information should be placed on the back of the entry for judging purposes. Exhibit tags will be provided by the Fair and will be attached at the time of receiving and while on display
4. Each entry in a class by the same exhibitor must be different in material and pattern
5. The Butte County Fair reserves the right to refuse to display items which have been deemed vulgar, in poor taste or inappropriate for display at a family arts and crafts show
6. Butte County Fair is not responsible for any theft/damage
7. Dedicated drop off will be available again this year, for **large and bulky items**. **Please contact the Fair office to schedule your time slot.** This will allow us to make appropriate arrangements for any special handling your project may require

If you have a large project, we encourage you to enter early so we can assess your display space needs 😊
