Eligibility for GRAND EXHIBITOR placing, Cathy's Sew-N-Vac gift Certificates and Rosettes:

To qualify for Grand Exhibitor you must compete in at least 3 (three) divisions in this department. The top three overall scores within the department will qualify for a first, second and third place. If there are not enough qualified Exhibitors to fill all three placings, only the highest places will be awarded. There is no fee, and no separate entry for Grand Exhibitor. It is calculated and awarded automatically based on highest overall scores. All Divisions and classes will be judged by skill, technique and design used.

DIVISION 306 – CLOTHING – CHILDREN - Any child's sewn clothing item, hand or machine.

Hangable items must be on hangers

DIVISION 307 – CLOTHING – ADULT – Any adult sewn clothing item, hand or machine.
Hangable items must be on hangers

DIVISION 308 – CLOTHING – ACCESSORIES – Any sewn accessory, hand or machine

CLASS:

1. Purses/Bags, specify

DIVISION 309 – KNITTED ARTICLES – Staff will do their best to display items in a way that minimizes any stretching, but cannot guarantee it.

CLASS:

1. Afghan
2. Baby Item

DIVISION 310 – CROCHETED ARTICLES - Staff will do their best to display items in a way that minimizes any stretching, but cannot guarantee it.

DIVISION 311 – QUILTS – 4” sleeve **REQUIRED** on all quilts over 48” x 70” **OR ANY quilt you do not wish to have hung or displayed by using needles or safety pins.** All quilts will be displayed with the utmost care and concern. Size of quilt must be indicated on entry

CLASS:

1. Quilt, baby, any, specify
2. Quilt, Holiday or seasonal
3. Quilt, wall hanging, any, specify
4. Quilt, Lap or twin, any, specify
5. Quilt, Full/Queen, any, specify
6. Quilt, King, any, specify
7. Quilt, any other size, hand appliqued, specify size
8. Quilt, any other size, machine appliqued, specify size
9. Quilt, any other size, hand embroidered, specify size
10. Quilt, any other size, machine embroidered, specify size
11. Quilt, any size, original (created by Exhibitor) pattern, specify size



QUILTS 312 – ANY OTHER QUILTED

CLASS:

1. Quilted wearable art, specify
2. Quilted purse/tote, any, specify
3. Quilted table runners/doilies, any, specify
4. Quilted linens/whole cloth, any, specify

QUILTS 313– GROUP QUILTS – Made by Exhibitor plus one or more additional quilters

CLASS:

1. Group quilt, any, specify size



These rules apply to both the Adult and corresponding Youth departments

ADULT & YOUTH CLOTHING, TEXTILES AND QUILTS

RULES:

1. All entries in this department must be made by the exhibitor from *start to finish* unless otherwise specified
2. Exhibits must not have been shown in any previous Butte County Fair year
3. All small pieces should be enclosed in a zip lock bag. Sets should be pinned or tacked together
4. Two or more entries entered in the same CLASS, must be different in material, pattern and style
5. If a special dye method or antique material was use, please nor it in the online entry
6. Articles must be clean and pressed. Judges will not consider items that are stained, soiled or show signs of wear for judging or display
7. The Fair will provide and attach ID tags at the time of entry receiving
8. "Any other" class is for items that so not fit into an existing class
9. 4" sleeve REQUIRED on all quilts over 48" x 70"
10. 4" sleeve RECOMMENDED on all quilts under 48" x 70"
