JUDGING: American and open to Public

Eligibility for GRAND EXHIBITOR placing, NO CASH PRIZE, ROSETTES ONLY: To qualify for Grand Exhibitor you must compete in at least 3 (three) divisions in this department. The top three overall scores within the department will qualify for a first, second and third place. If there are not enough qualified Exhibitors to fill all three placings, only the highest places will be awarded. There is no fee, and no separate entry for Grand Exhibitor. It is calculated and awarded automatically based on highest overall scores.

PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD: Fair goers visiting Expo Hall between Fair Open on Thursday, August 22, 2023 and Noon on Sunday, August 25, 2023 are eligible to cast their vote for

their favorite exhibit. At 12:30PM on Sunday, August 25, 2023, all votes will be tallied, and the People's Choice Award given.

TIPS AND TRICKS FOR SUBMITTING YOUR FINE ART PROJECT:

- 1. All exhibits in this department must have been completed after August 2023, and must not have been shown at any previous Butte County Fair.
- 2. All painting and drawings must be suitably framed and **ready** to hang.
- 3. Paintings must be dry, no "wet" work will be accepted.
- 4. Frames consist of wood or plastic frames, or heavy, duty mat board frames and must be in good "show worthy" condition.
- 5. Broken frames will be rejected.
- 6. All heavy pieces must have wire affixed with suitable strength to hold the picture.
- 7. **Unframed artwork will not be accepted**, although Staff may choose to move the entry to the Crafts, Home & Industrial Arts department, *when suitable*.
- 8. Names are NOT permitted on the front of the artwork and will be covered by Fair staff prior to judging, in order to facilitate "fair" blind judging practices
- 9. You may affix an ID label to the upper left, hand corner of the back of the entry showing the name, address and phone number of the exhibitor

These rules apply to both the Adult and corresponding Youth departments

ADULT & YOUTH FINE ARTS RULES:

- 1. In Fine Arts, Beginner is defined as someone who engages in the creation of artworks as a hobby or for the love of the work
- 2. Experienced is defined as someone who engages in the creation of artworks as a hobby or for the love of the work for *a lengthy time* OR who puts their art on display with the intention of selling for monetary profit. Art instructors or teachers are considered experienced
- 3. All exhibits in this department must have been completed after August 2023 and must not have been shown at any previous Butte County Fair
- <u>4.</u> All paintings and drawings are to be framed and ready for hanging. <u>Any exhibit</u>

 <u>that is not suitably framed will be refused or moved to a more appropriate</u>

 <u>department!</u>
- 5. Frames consist of wood or plastic frames or heavy-duty mat board frames and are to be in good condition suitable for hanging. Heavy pieces should have affixed wire with suitable strength to hold picture
- 6. Unframed artwork should be entered in the Crafts Dept Q
- 7. Fragile or unstable items may be eliminated
- 8. List the size of the painting/drawing (including the frame) in description box of the online entry form
- 9. Names are not permitted on the front of the artwork and will be covered by Fair staff prior to Judging. Judging is "blind", which means the Judge cannot know the name of the Exhibitor
- 10. An ID label should be affixed to the upper left-hand corner of the back of the entry showing the name, address and phone number of the exhibitor
- 11.Items will be moved by the Fair staff. Fair and/or Management is not responsible for damage
- 12. Management reserves the right to remove any item not deemed appropriate for a family based Fair Fine Arts show
