7. A penalty of \$35.00 must be paid if a check paid to the Butte County Fair is refused by the bank. Only cash, certified checks or money orders are acceptable for penalty payments. Nonpayment of original money or penalty may result in cancellation of entries.

66. In the event that an animal is a "No Sale" (the exhibitor gets no bids on the animal) Small animals will be "resold" at an amount decided by the board of directors and livestock committee. Large animals will be resold at the market price for that week. COMMISSION & FEES WILL STILL BE TAKEN OUT OF EXHIBITORS CHECK EVEN IF THE ANIMAL IS SOLD AT RESALE PRICE.

67. All exhibitors are required to turn in a Thank You letter that has been stamped and addressed to their buyers, award sponsors, and add-on/bump bid donors when auction check is collected.

101. There will be a 5% commission on cattle and 8% on all other species sold through the Junior Livestock Auction, to be automatically deducted from the exhibitor's gross sale price.
