✓		10. Does the sponsor provide in its wellness policy a plan for <b>annual review</b> ( <i>as required by K-20 Education Code 1003.453</i> ) to evaluate and measure the implementation of the LSWP?

Does the sponsor provide a plan for conducting the <b>triennial progress assessments</b> <b>and</b> making appropriate updates or modifications to the policy based on the following? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The extent to which each school under the jurisdiction of the LEA is in compliance with the local school wellness policy;</li> <li>• The extent to which the sponsor's local school wellness policy compares to model local school wellness policies; and</li> <li>• A description of the progress made in attaining the goals of the local school wellness policy.</li> </ul>
