



Mrs. Marguerite DeSleet Johnson was the beloved and esteemed wife of Rev. Lovell Johnson, Sr. She served faithfully as a Missionary and leader of Christian Education at St. Mark A.M.E Church from 1964, when Rev. Johnson was assigned pastor, until their untimely death in 1991.

Mrs. Johnson is remembered by all who knew her as a dedicated Christian woman, who was devoted to the youth of the church and was an outstanding leader, mentor and teacher. Mrs. Johnson served as Missionary Advisor, President of the Geraldine Bradford Missionary Society, Chairperson for the Christian Social Relations Committee and as Fourth District Promotion and Missionary Education Director. At the time of her death, Mrs. Johnson was serving as the Fourth Episcopal District's First Vice-President. She had been a delegate to the Quadrennial Women's Missionary Society Convention on numerous occasions and was also a life member of the Missionary Society. She shared her husband's ministry at St. Mark and served as volunteer Director of Christian Education.

Mrs. Johnson wrote materials for use by the Missionary Society and the Christian Education Department of the African Methodist Episcopal Church. Her works include Bible Stories, A Catechism Workbook, The Sarah Allen Cookbook, Vacation Bible School materials and the History of the Chicago Annual Conference Women's Missionary Society. She served on several board of Directors and received numerous awards for her involvement and contributions. Mrs. Johnson exemplified the Biblical definition of what a Christian woman should be. It is in her honor that this Book Scholarship is awarded. It is hoped that the young people who receive this scholarship will use it to attain higher education and will use their gifts and talents to the glory of God and to enhance and further the mission of the A.M.E Church.
