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*“Why do you look for the living among the dead?” the men ask. We too, can get stuck looking for and then doing things that don’t bring us life. Jesus – the Risen Christ – is the one who brings us real Life. We belong to Christ (through His death and resurrection) and God is already in relationship with us. Today, if even for a little while, leave at the tomb what is draining life from you. For He is a living Lord, ready to bring you new life!*

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Let’s try that together...“Leave it at the tomb, **for Jesus is Alive!**”

That’s good – really good. You sound like you believe Jesus is alive. And I’m not seeing any of you carrying the spices and ointments to do the last rites of preparing Jesus’ body for burial. Therefore, I think you do believe Jesus is alive.

But the women, they didn’t know what to think. Jesus had been their spiritual teacher. They respected Him deeply. Plus, He had this way of knowing you and seeing you; almost like He knew what you were thinking. It was very comforting actually. Now He’s been killed by the state and the women only want to honor him this last time.

Not only is the tomb open, but there are two men saying Jesus is alive! They ask a very curious question. **“Why do you look for the living among the dead?”**

Why do you look for the living among the dead? None of us go to the cemetery expecting our loved one to be sitting there alive. The cemetery with all the tombstones is the place of the dead. Yet these men are adamant that Jesus was dead but is now very much alive. That means Jesus is not only alive, but fully the spiritual teacher and the intimate confidant He always was! It also means our grief at seeing Him on the cross – well we can “Leave it at the tomb, **for Jesus is Alive!**”
