Worship Listening Sessions

In the early fall of 2022, 91 people responded to a four-question survey. We took the survey to see what your ministry priorities were in the formation of our 2023 Mission & Ministry plan; King of Glory's budget. You responded that worship, music,

youth and outreach were your top priorities. In addition, because we were considering all options for saving money at that point, we also included questions about moving to one worship service on Sundays. Or cancelling Saturday night and keeping both services on Sundays.

72 respondents were in favor of moving to one worship service. 19 were not.

<u>Now, I want to explore why.</u> If we don't know the reasons, making a change could produce a counterproductive move with more harm than good. To that end, we will have five Worship Listening Sessions in January.

We will listen and learn. The rationale behind this listening comes from seminary training about 'systems'. Church systems are like family systems. Any family can only handle so much stress at one time before the stress creates harm. Our church system has been under financial stress and Pastor Deb has also departed. While we are in a healthier financial place now, her absence won't be our "new normal" for many months.

The Leadership Team and I want to come to a decision after hearing your rationale and opinions. We will do that in February. I really hope you will come to one of these listening sessions and enter into the conversation. God is with us! *Pastor Ruth Ann*
